Show schedule for February 19th through March 25th

Each skater will perform in at least two numbers. Skaters were grouped based on levels and ability attained by December, and each new skating level requires certain elements for mastery. Please recognize that this may not be the skater's current level.

Please make sure that you check this schedule carefully so that you do not miss any of the practice times. Also, please be sure that your skater is at the rink and ready to go on the ice at the time of his/her lesson. Due to the extra practices, your skater may be scheduled for more than one night during the week **and** on weekends. It is VERY important to be at all of the practices. If your skater has two unexcused absences, the coach has the option to remove your skater from that number.

Featured skaters are required to put in extra time on their own for their routines!!!!

Costume fittings will probably begin the 2nd week in February. Every attempt will be made to schedule fittings when your skater is already at the rink for practice; however occasional conflicts may arise. A detailed schedule will be sent out soon.

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER:

Friday, March 9th –**ALL SKATERS** show pictures – Start at 4:30 pm - Schedule TBA

Please be there and ready to go when your skater is scheduled as this will make everything run much smoother! Also, double check that you have all the pieces of your outfit along (nylons, boot covers, etc.). These photos will be handed out at the end of the year gathering. After each group has pictures taken, those skaters are free to leave. Also, this year we plan to have an '**ALL CAST**' picture taken on ice.

March 23rd- 5:00pm. **Dress rehearsal.** We will be **STARTING** at 5:00, so please make sure you are at the rink by 4:30. Each group will have a designated locker room. A list of skaters that belong in each room will be posted on every door. **We will begin with the Finale order first** (running through it twice), **so please be on time.** Although we practice the finale first, skaters should dress in the outfit they **perform in first!** (For the actual show, skaters will be in the outfit they performed in last.) Once your skater is finished with his/her last routine, s/he is free to leave. *We will be ordering pizza for supper during the 'mock' intermission. Cost and additional information will follow as the date approaches.

March 24th- Practice. We will have ice from 9-12noon for any solos or groups that need extra practice.

*****SHOW STARTS AT 7 PM***** - Everyone needs to be at the rink and ready to go by 6:30 PM. Freestyle skaters and TEAM will have a quick warm up at 6:00 PM to run through routines, if necessary.

March 25th- *****SHOW STARTS AT 2 PM***** Please make sure your skater is at the rink by 1:30 PM. Again, please make sure s/he is in the right locker room! **Everyone is encouraged to assist with tear-down after the show!!!!**
